Introduction:

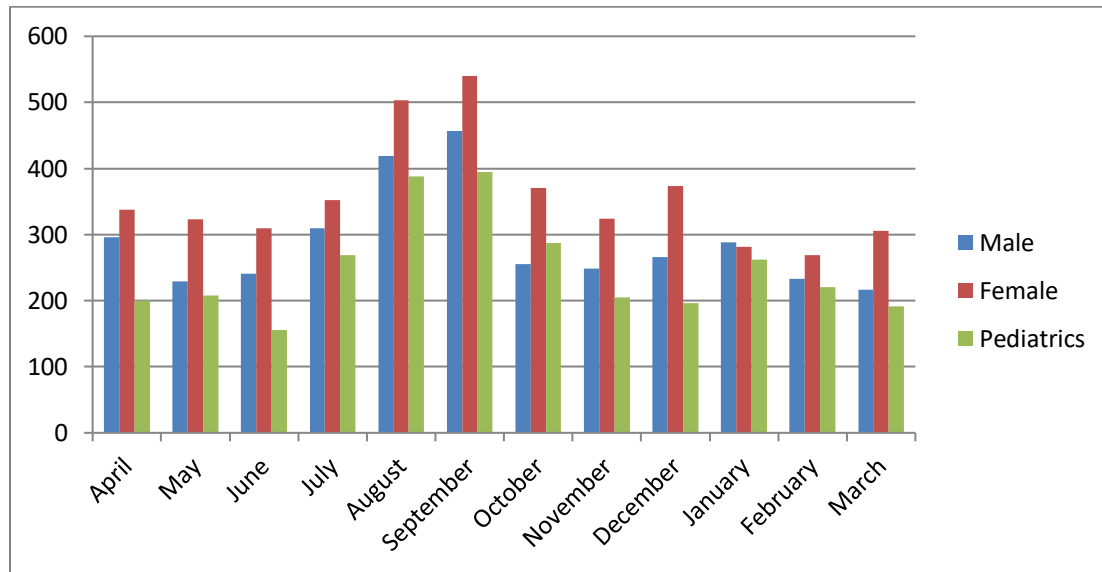
Janeev Rugnalay is our very first program started in January 2021. Team of 6 Health workers with 1 MBBS physician and 1 BDS Dentist provides the services on daily basis and being residential. Dr. Suraj Mhaske Execute the team on daily basis. We provide outpatient service from 9 am to 2 pm at registration cost of Rs. 20 and emergency service 24 hours at Rs. 50 registration charges. Along with these we provide basic laboratory service, generic medicines at affordable rates and ambulance service.

Activities done during April 2022- March 2023

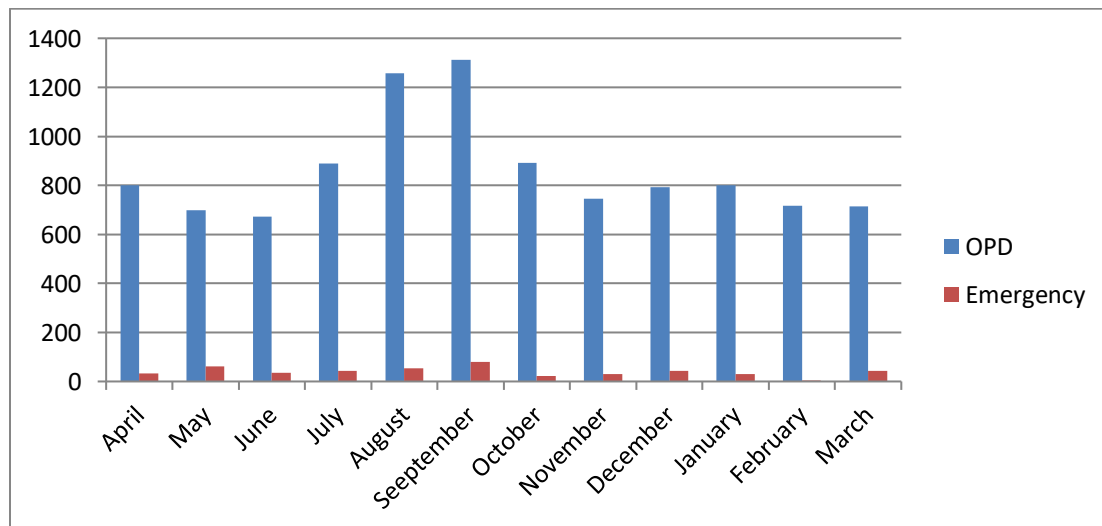
- In last year hospital had provided 10299 consultations in OPD time and 476 consultations in emergency to rural and tribal patients, 5249 lab tests are carried over, 183 patients provided with day care service, 27 Provided with ambulance service and 161 are referred to higher centre. 292 ANC and 451 PNC patients are being examined.
- Hospital had arranged cancer diagnostic camp with TATA CANCER CARE PROGRAM CHANDRAPUR at Dabgaon patients are screened for HBsAg, Hepatitis C, Breast cancer, Oral cancer and cervical cancer.
- The ophthalmic check up camp been arranged and patients examined by Dr. Sagar Rajurkar (M.S. OPHTHALMOLOGY). 257 patients been examined and 45 patients diagnosed for cataract operation.
- Tarunybhan” the adolescent education programm designed by SEARCH team had been arranged in Vikas Vidyalay at Vihirgaon for 10 AND 12 th class students.
- For 5 to 8 th class school health checkup camp been arranged at Vikas Vidyalay Vihirgaon
- Dental unit had been added as special service to existing clinic.

- Mobile clinic had been started in 2 villages Dabgaon and Usarpar Chak providing regular monthly health service.
- Anti superstition program, Cultural program and sport event program arranged on Annual function Day

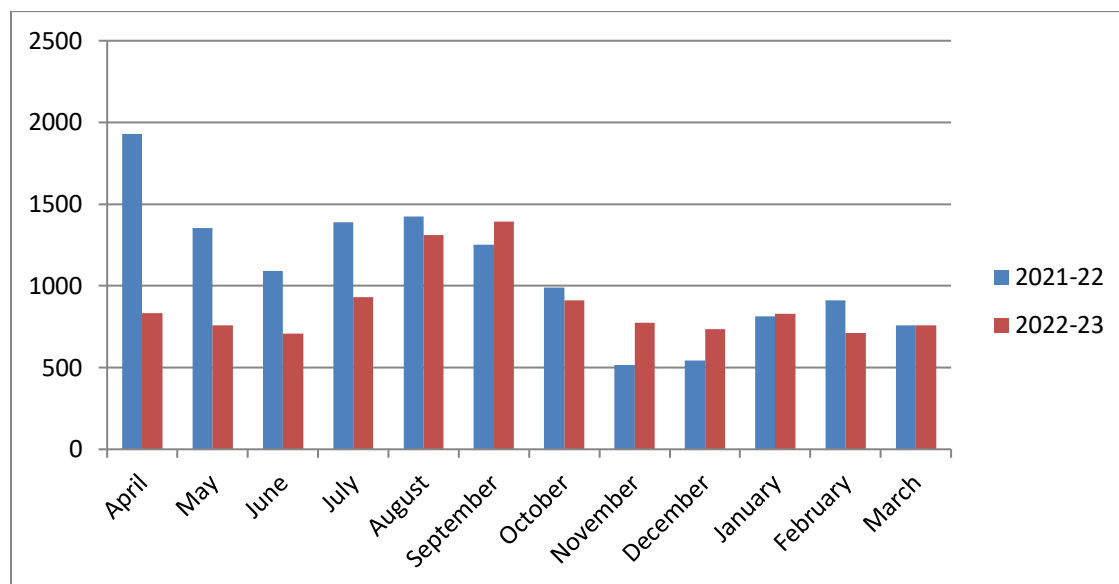
Sex wise distribution of patients visits in different months year 2022-2023:

- Regular Laboratory and Medicine dispensary assisted to clinic between OPD timing.
- Regular Emergency service 6 days per week between 2 PM to 6 AM
- Mobile Clinic in 8 different villages in evening i.e 4 PM onwards to 8PM time once in a Month.
- Regular ambulance service.
- Health Education and Checkup activity in around 50 villages about Hypertension and Oral Health Problems.
- Health Education, Adolescent education and Deaddiction education activity in and Around 4 schools and colleges.
- Yearly specialty camp 1. Eye check and cataract diagnostic camp and mobilization of Patient for operative procedure.
- Sport activity in Geora Bk. of male and female of for surrounding service seeking Villages.
